LAUNCH OF 'RAKSHITA' INITIATIVE

The Commissioner (Transport) indicated the trends that women are not feeling safe while journey in the Night and such initiative will provide safety to women commuters in Delhi and will also boost the morale of women by making them financially independent. Commissioner(Transport) also expressed his all support for providing training to interested women/females for obtaining commercial vehicle license and for operation of vehicles for female commuters. All the participants were very encouraged from this initiative and ready to participate in training programme.
